Overview

This qualification offers an introduction to the protective services sector: uniformed public services such as police, fire service, armed services and prison service. The qualification supports progression to higher education when taken as part of a programme of study that includes other A Level or applied general qualifications. Level 3 Protective Services will provide you with a good grounding in the theory and practical skills that you need to know and the fitness and discipline that you are required to have for a degree or career in the protective services sector.

What will I learn?

The units you study may include:

- ▲ Public service skills
- ▲ Improving health and fitness
- ▲ Land navigation and expedition skills
- ▲ Team development in protective services

How will I learn?

Lessons will be a mixture of theory and practical lessons, and, wherever possible, underpinning theory will also be demonstrated in a practical context. There will be a variety of assessment methods used (such as written assessments, observations, presentations, discussions and examinations), and you will gain a thorough understanding of the evidence you are expected to produce.
